Direct Sell – After a flight segment

The computer will read pick-up airport, date and time of arrival from the flight segment specified, in this example segment 1. The system assumes the airport, date, arrival and drop times from the previous and following flight segments.

AAN	Avis Assigned Number - <i>for non-ABTA agents</i>
ACRISS	Association of Car Rental Industry Systems Standards (<i>for European Car Rental Companies</i>)
ALI	Additional Liability Insurance (<i>USA only</i>) - <i>Motor liability cover up to US\$ 1 million for third parties, including passengers</i>
AWD	Avis Worldwide Discount number - <i>an Avis code which provides a customer or group of customers access to Avis special rates</i>
CDW	Collision Damage Waiver - <i>Covers accidental damage to the vehicle</i>
Express Preferred	Avis' speed of service programme
FlyDrive	Airline and Car rental package, programme or product
FTN	Frequent Traveller Number - <i>reference number or code for Frequent Traveller Programme</i>
FTP	Frequent Traveller Programme
GDS	Global Distribution Systems - <i>Global reservations systems for the travel industry e.g. Galileo</i>
PAI	Personal Accident Insurance - <i>Covers death or injury to driver and passengers while with the vehicle</i>
T&M	Time and Mileage - <i>relating to a car rental, duration and mileage covered</i>
TMI	Time, Mileage and Insurances
TID	Travel Industry Designator - <i>alternative to an IATA number</i>
TP	Theft Protection (<i>Europe & Africa only</i>) - <i>Covers loss or damage to the vehicle caused by theft</i>
VIPCO	VIP Company - <i>relates to Company or Business account or special rate</i>
VLF	Vehicle License Fee - <i>Local Government tax applicable in some countries as a rental registration fee</i>
